

# Grand Knight's Message-

"No Priests, No Sacraments, No Church"

That was the reality for Catholics in post-war Poland as the Nazis had systematically executed and destroyed an entire generation of priests. In fact, many priests were crucified on the altars and in the sanctuaries of churches as a visible sign of the Nazis' contempt for the Church. However, out of this horror arose the greatest Catholic of our time, a young Father Karol Wojtyla, who would later become our beloved Pope John Paul the Great.

While much is publicized in the popular media about the shortage of priests in our nation, I am grateful to see that the parishes of Avon and Avon Lake currently have five men in the seminary discerning God's call to the priesthood. We can be hopeful that out of the pain of the clergy sex abuse scandal, the Holy Spirit remains active calling men to the vocation of the priesthood and assuring that the sacraments will be available to all who seek God's grace.

We should take the opportunity to recognize the courage that these seminarians possess in answering God's call to the priesthood. By answering God's call to the priesthood, they are "swimming upstream" against the values of our secular and materialistic society by recognizing God's presence in their lives and His desire for each and every person to have an intimate relationship with his Son.

We should also appreciate the talents and sacrifices of the wonderful priests who serve our parishes. We are fortunate to have the sacraments readily available to us at all times. We may take it for granted that a priest will be present for Sunday Mass, Saturday Confession, the baptism of our children and grandchildren, or to give the Last Rites to sick and dying family members. Without their commitment to us, we would find ourselves in the very same plight as the post-war Polish Catholics.
