# Grand Knight's Message

“A Man for All Seasons”

St. Thomas More's life is an example of an often overlooked quality of the truly Catholic man - **fidelity to the Faith**, even to the point of death. Born on February 7, 1477, to a prosperous English family, St. Thomas More initially thought of studying for the priesthood but instead opted for a career in the law. He noted that he would rather be a “good husband than a bad priest.” As he rose in professional prominence, he was knighted by King Henry VIII and was named Chancellor of England, the highest position held by a non-royal in that day.


However, he is remembered for his opposition to King Henry VIII's decision to dismiss the authority of Rome. As you may recall, Henry sought a divorce from Katherine of Aragon and the Pope denied Henry's request to allow the divorce. This resulted in Henry creating the Church of England.

As St. Thomas More openly opposed Henry's plan to marginalize the authority of the Supreme Pontiff and to create the Church of England, he found himself imprisoned in the Tower of London. Initially, he was incarcerated with an ample supply of provisions. As the days passed and his opposition to Henry's defiance of the Church remained unwavering, the provisions were removed to the point where St. Thomas More was left with nothing to sustain his existence.

Finally, a day was set for his execution. On the eve of his execution, his daughter presented him with a final option (derived by Henry)- in a decree, sign away his allegiance to Rome and live. His daughter urged him to sign in order to save his life stating, “No one will know that you signed it.” St. Thomas More responded, “But God will know.” The following day, July 6, 1535, he was beheaded outside of the gates of the Tower of London. Prior to his execution and before the assembled crowd he proclaimed, “The King's good servant, but God's first.”

St. Thomas More was canonized on May 19, 1935. St. Thomas More's extraordinary life and virtue should inspire us to greater fidelity to our Church and to have courage to face the challenges brought by those seeking to discredit our Faith.

## ELECTION NEWS


Council Elections are coming up and there are several opportunities to step up and help.
