“The Year of the Priest”

As you may be aware from the May edition of Columbia, Pope Benedict has declared June 19, 2009 through June 19, 2010 as the “Year of the Priest.” While this proclamation appears rather simple, further reflection on the role and formation of the priest suggests that there is a call for each one of us during this upcoming celebration and recognition of the priesthood.

The lay faithful may not see much of a role in either the formation of priests or in their support as Holy Orders are often viewed as a “special” vocation seemingly distinct from either the married or single states. We often underestimate or fail to recognize the humanity as well as the gift of those called to the priesthood. Our priests need our prayers—prayers for support, strength, and guidance. They also need our prayers just as any other soul is in constant need of the prayers of others and God's grace.

We also need to be active both in prayerful and material support of our seminarians and those discerning God's call in their lives. They need to know that we value the sacrifice they are making in “swimming upstream” against an increasingly secular culture.
