On May 17th we had the Quarterly Communion at St. Mary's Parish at the 8 AM Mass and a coffee and doughnut reception after that Mass and the 10 AM Mass. Identity Theft to over 35 members and guests. DGK Kevin McHenry and I attended the 116th Annual Ohio State Convention May 22th to 24th. We learned about accomplishments in the current fraternal year and the priorities and goals for the coming year. The Council received six awards at the Convention and these awards will be noted at the June 4th business meeting. Unfortunately, no one from our Council won in the Super Cash Bonanza drawings, however, we as a Council won big time because we sold 1176 tickets which resulted in net profit to the Council of \$2,858.54 that will be used for charitable distribu-

tions in the coming year! At a ceremony on May 31th we presented scholarship money to five High School students and eleven College students to help defer their tuition, book and lab fees. The Father Ragan Charitable Foundation gave \$300 to each high school student and \$600 to each college student and the Isabella Guild presented \$100 to each high school student and \$175 to each college students. This year's Measure Up campaign generated \$8,542, a 15% increase over last year! A special thanks to PGK Dan Pult in heading up the Walmart and Church collections.

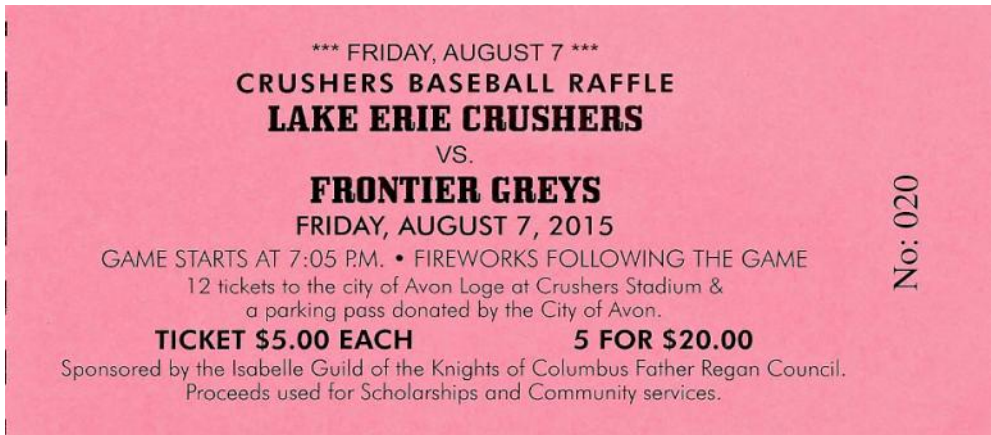

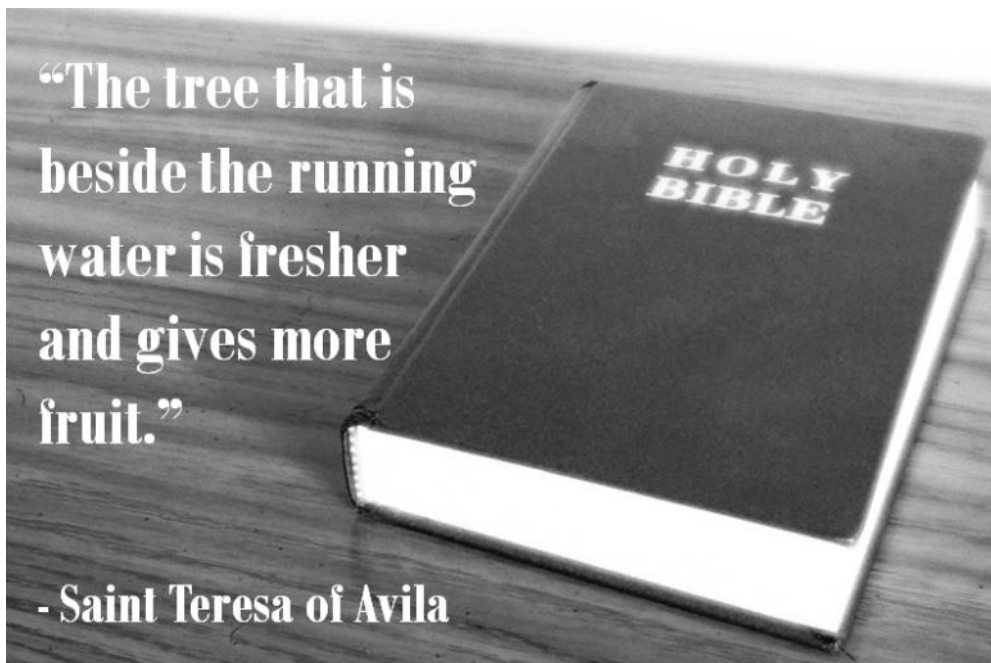
Crusher's Baseball Loge Raffle
